



Erlingur Páll Ingvarsson (1952) býr og starfar í Reykjavík. Hann stundaði nám við Myndlista- og handíðaskóla Íslands árin 1974-1978. Eftir það fór hann í framhaldsnám til Hollands í De Vrije Academie Den Haag með búsetu í Amsterdam og síðan til Þýskalands í Den Stadtliche Kunstacademie, Düsseldorf. Listamenn á borð við Joseph Beauys og Nam June Paik lifðu þá og störfuðu í Düsseldorf og voru viðriðnir listaháskólann. Það var mikil aðdráttarafl. Erlingur Páll á að baki sjö einkasýningar og nokkrar samsýningar. Listform Erlings Páls hefur spannað vitt svið: meðal annars skúptúr innsetningar, gjörninga, ljósmyndir og texta en hann hefur nú um langt skeið notað málverk sem sinn aðal miðil. Erlingur var virkur meðlimur á upphafssárum Nýlistasafnsins og um tíma í stjórn þess.

Erlingur Páll Ingvarsson (b. 1952) lives and works in Reykjavík. He studied at the Icelandic College of Arts and Crafts (the forerunner to the Iceland Academy of the Arts) from 1974-1978. He went on to live in Amsterdam while studying at the De Vrije Academie Den Haag, and subsequently studied at Den Stadtliche Kunstacademie in Düsseldorf, Germany. Artists including Joseph Beauys and Nam June Paik lived and worked in Düsseldorf at that time and were associated with the Academy, which was a major draw for Erlingur. Painting has been Erlingur's main medium of expression for a number of years. He has held seven solo exhibitions and participated in a number of joint exhibitions, ranging from sculptural installations and performance art to photographs with text. Erlingur was an active member of the Living Art Museum in Reykjavík in its early years, and was, for a time, on its board.


